We live in a world where people look only after themselves in this moment. We do that using nonrenewable sources of energy, throwing garbage in woods and producing exhaust fumes. We need to think of future because we are not going to be here in the next 1000 years but our progeny will. Everything we do today has a reflection in the future. As a true example of a city that thinks of future, I would like to point at Šibenik. Šibenik has nearby river Krka with Jaruga Hydroelectric Power plant, the first commercial hydro power plant in Europe and second in the world, five wind farms on the hills. In addition, on buildings they put solar panels for example Jolly Eco which is a center for processing packaging. Solar panels are also used on houses for water heating and electric power. In Šibenik, you can also find hybrid buses. However, Šibenik isn't the only environmentally friendly city. One Croatian made an electric car. The name of the car is Rimac. Electric cars aren't any slower than ordinary cars, their only flaw is battery. I think that more people should drive that kind of a car.
